



ACCESS WORLD TERMINALS B.V. TRAFFIC AND SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Entry to these premises is at your own risk
2. Always follow the instructions of Access World Terminals personnel.
3. We refuse information or (unaccompanied) goods that must be delivered to another person.
4. Our company employees or any individuals from third parties employed by us, cannot be held liable for any injuries, damages or goods incurred at our terminal.
5. Access World traffic regulations apply on the premises at all times:
 - a. Always obey traffic signs.
 - b. Work traffic always has right of way.
 - c. Maximum speed on roads: 30 km/hour.
 - d. Maximum speed in buildings: 5 km/hour.
6. The following safety clothing must be worn at all times:
 - a. Reflective clothing.
 - b. Safety footwear.
 - c. Helmet.
7. Filming, photographing, smoking and drinking alcohol on the terminal is prohibited.
8. Leaving your vehicle while waiting and entering a building or machine without the accompaniment of Access World Terminals personnel is prohibited.
9. Never pass a machine without having had proper eye contact with the machine operator.
10. Pedestrians must walk along the side of the road, on the shoulder or along walking routes designated by marking stripes. Unnecessary stopping and roaming around at the terminal is prohibited: the shortest possible route to the destination must be followed.
11. When access is granted with a car, always use the existing warning lighting and park in the designated parking spots.
12. Compulsory identification and visitor's regulations apply on our entire premises. We reserve the right to inspect your vehicle, baggage, clothing and any contents.
13. Entering the terminal under the influence of alcohol or drugs is prohibited. In the event of suspected alcohol or drug use you will be immediately removed from the terminal.
14. Access World Terminals employees are at all times, without any need for justification, authorised to refuse any individuals access or to remove them from the terminal.
15. This terminal operates in accordance with EC 725/2004 (ISPS Code) for the security of ships and harbour facilities. Authorised access can only be granted following registration at our online and/or at our office. Unauthorised access constitutes a violation of the rules and will be reported to the competent authorities.
16. The information obtained during the visit is confidential and may not be shared.
17. When leaving the terminal, you must report your departure at the reception.
